Introduction: An awareness programme on “Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 “ is organized by the Village and Adoption Cell, in collaboration with IQAC, Chilarai College, Golakganj in the adopted school : 131 No Chakkar line L.P School. The programme begins at 10 am on 13/06/2024. The programme is chaired by Mr. Tarani Kanta Biswas, Co-ordinator/Convener of the Village and Adoption Cell, Chilarai College. Mr. Prince Zakir Abdullah, Assistant Prof., Deptt of Political Science is the Resource Person. The speaker focuses on the proper implementation of The Right to Education Act (RTE), 2009. He opines that the stated Act has been a landmark legislation in India that guarantees free and compulsory education to children between the ages of 6 and 14. Despite its importance, there remains a significant lack of awareness among both guardians and students regarding the provisions and implications of this act. To address this gap, this awareness programme is organized with a view to disseminating information about RTE, its significance, and how it can be effectively implemented.

Objectives:

1. To educate guardians and students about their rights and entitlements under the Right to Education Act, 2009.
2. To raise awareness about the importance of education and its role in the overall development of children.
3. To empower guardians and students to actively participate in the implementation of RTE and ensure its effective enforcement.
4. To address common misconceptions and doubts regarding RTE.

Programme Details:

Date and Venue: The awareness programme was held on 13/06/2024 at 131 No Chakkar Line L.P School, Golakganj.

Participants: Guardians and Students from various socio-economic backgrounds were invited to participate in the programme. There are 63 participants present in the programme.

Resource Persons: Prince Zakir Abdullah, Assistant Professor, Dept of Political Science, Chilarai College has acted as resource person of the programme and he has highlighted the following topics in his lecture.

- Introduction to the Right to Education Act, 2009: A detailed explanation of the key provisions of RTE, including free and compulsory education,

infrastructure norms for schools, teacher-student ratio, and prohibition of discrimination.

- Importance of Education: Discussions and presentations highlighting the significance of education in personal, social, and economic development.
- Rights and Responsibilities: Clarification of the rights of children and guardians under RTE, along with their corresponding responsibilities towards ensuring quality education.
- Interactive Sessions: Question-answer sessions and group discussions to address queries and concerns raised by the participants.
- Role of Guardians and Students: Guidance on how guardians and students can actively contribute to the effective implementation of RTE through monitoring, reporting violations, and advocacy.



Outcomes:

- Increased Awareness: Participants gained a better understanding of RTE and its implications, leading to increased awareness about their rights and entitlements.
- Empowerment: Guardians and students felt empowered to demand their rights and hold authorities accountable for the proper implementation of RTE.
- Community Engagement: The programme fostered community engagement and collaboration, with participants expressing a willingness to actively support efforts to improve education in their locality.
- Dispelling Misconceptions: Many misconceptions and doubts regarding RTE were addressed, leading to greater clarity and confidence among the participants.
