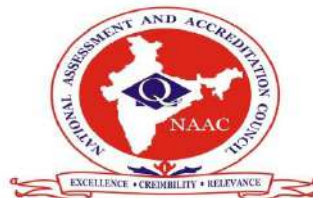

Introduction

On 25th April 2023, the Department of Assamese at Chilarai College, Golakganj organized a field study at Bisandai Karmakar Para. The objective of the field survey was to study and document the lifestyle, customs, culture, and traditions of the Karmakar community, who are predominantly blacksmiths.

Objectives

To understand the historical background of Bisandai Karmakar Para Village.

To study the lifestyle and customs of the Karmakar people.

To document the folk culture, including songs, beliefs, and dramas.

To explore traditional food habits and folk tales.


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Key Findings:

The survey was conducted through direct interaction with the villagers, observation, and participation in various cultural activities. The students and faculty members interviewed the local people, attended demonstrations of blacksmithing, and participated in cultural performances.

Historical Background:

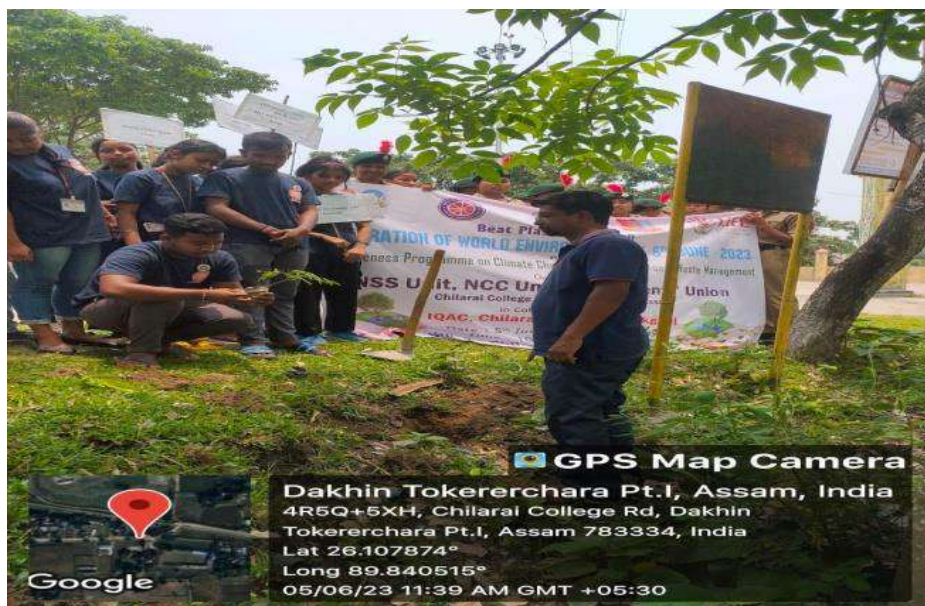

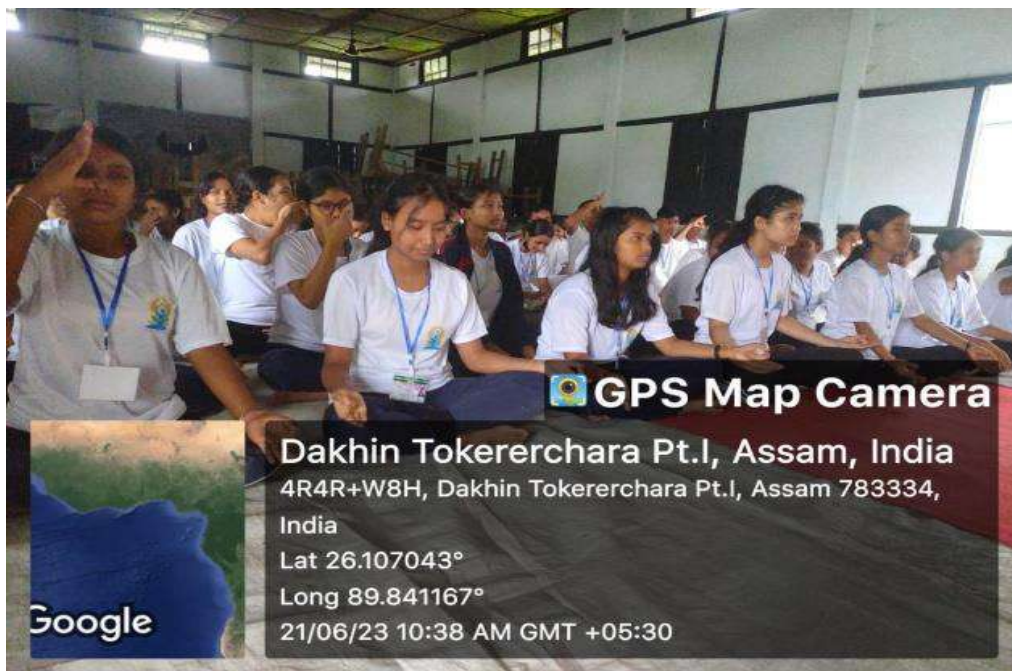

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100 Hours Saha-Yoga Shikshak Prashikshan Shibir

Panel Discussion:

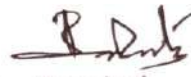
- A panel discussion involving students, faculty, and guest speakers explored preventive measures and support systems available for those struggling with substance abuse.

Field Study Report:
Alokjhari Mohamaya Dham and Paglahat Village
Organized by: Department of Assamese, Chilarai College, Golakganj

On March 20, 2021, the Department of Assamese at Chilarai College, Golakganj, conducted a comprehensive field study at Alokjhari Mohamaya Dham. This educational excursion was led by Dr. Umesh Das, Mr. Alakesh Chandra Roy and Nirmala Roy all of whom are Assistant Professors in the department. The program carried active participation from 16 students.

Objectives of the Field Study:

- To explore and document the historical and cultural significance of Alokjhari Mohamaya Dham.
- To understand the customs, lifestyle, and folklore of the residents of Paglahat Village.

Alokjhari Mohamaya Dham: Historical and Cultural Insights

The historic Ma Mahamayadham of Alokjhari, established over 200 years ago, is believed to have been built by Raja Prabhat Chandra Baruah. Legends suggest that Lord Shiva cut down the dead body of his wife Sati, and the footprints fell at the center of the Alokjhari hillock. Baruah had a dream where a saint named Saschidananda handed over the golden idol of Goddess Durga and directed him to construct a temple over the footprints. Despite allegations of Brahmin occupying the land, daily puja rituals continue. In 1974, Congress leader Jadabananda Adhikary formed a managing committee to manage the temple. The temple is 15 km away from Dhubri-Kachugaon Road, and devotees find it difficult to attend the rituals year-round.

The local residents of Paglahat, particularly from the village of Paglahat, provided invaluable cooperation and insights during the study. They elaborated on several key aspects:

1. History of Alokjhari Mohamaya Dham: The site holds significant historical importance, which was thoroughly explained by the villagers.
2. Fair and Festivals: The dham is a vibrant center for various fairs and festivals, showcasing the cultural richness of the area.


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Key Sites and Features:

- 5 Jhora: A notable feature with historical relevance.
- Bagh Ghar: An area of interest due to its unique history and structure.
- Kakshila: A site with cultural and possibly archaeological importance.
- Snanghat: A bathing site with religious significance.

The awareness programme orchestrated by the NCC Unit of Chilarai College, Golakganj, stood as a shining example of community mobilization in the face of a public health crisis.


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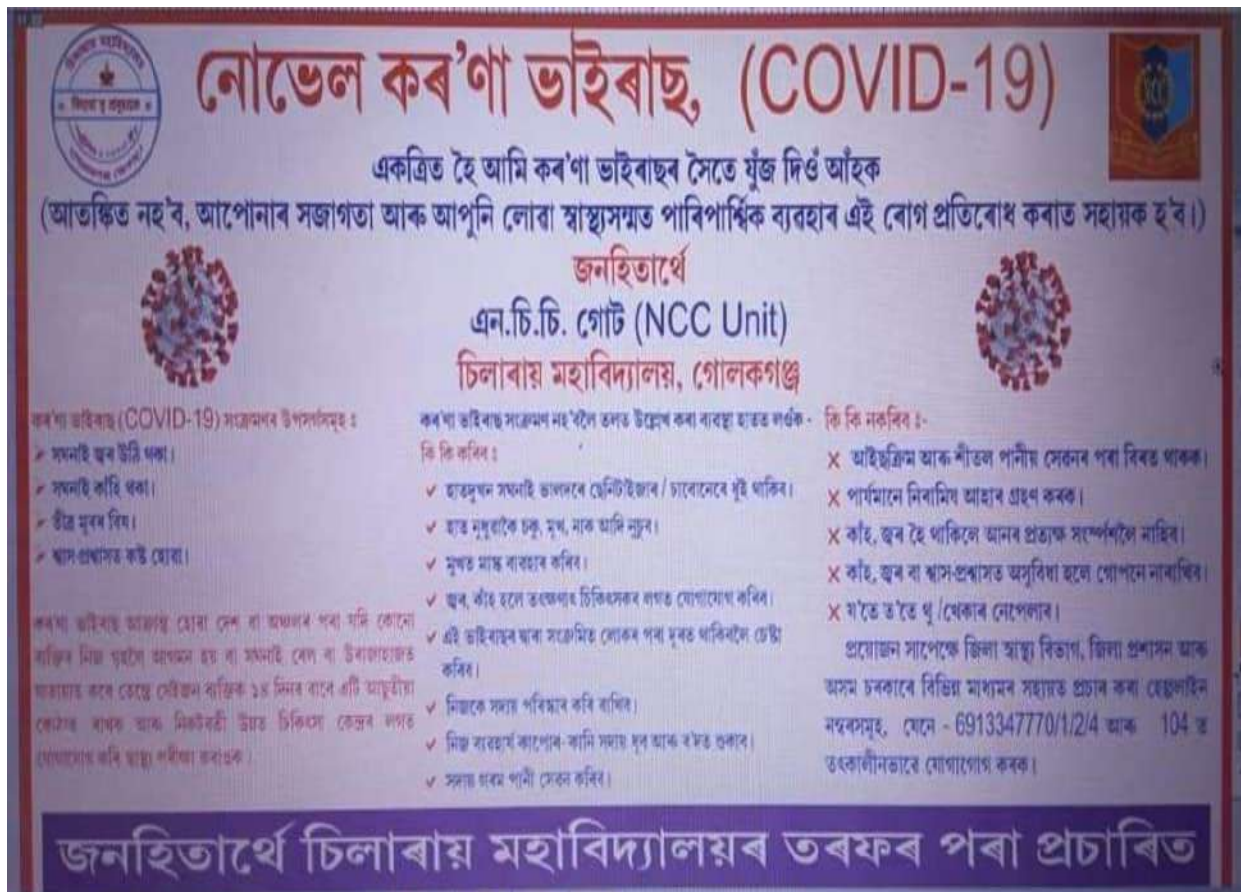

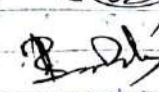

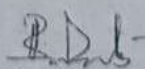
