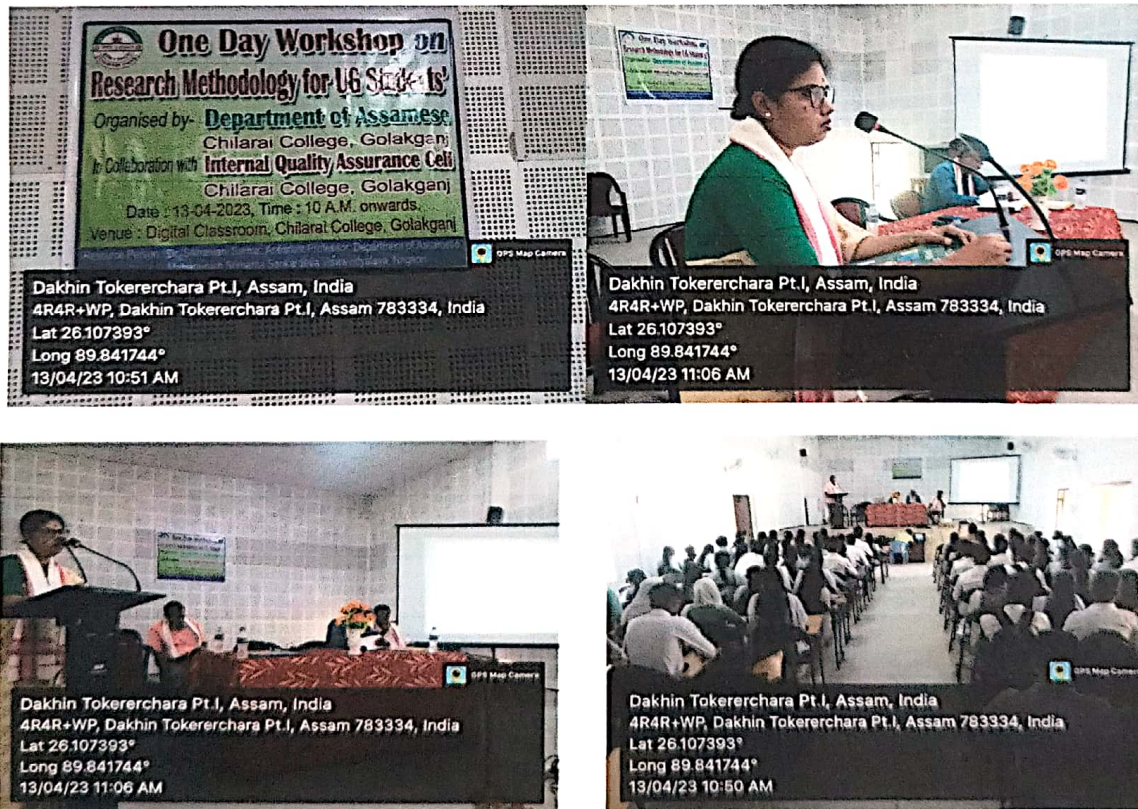
7. Research Presentation and Communication: Techniques for producing research reports, disseminating findings to a range of audiences, and successfully presenting research findings.

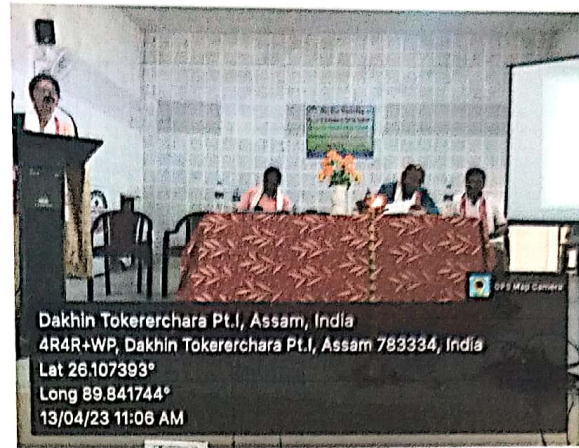
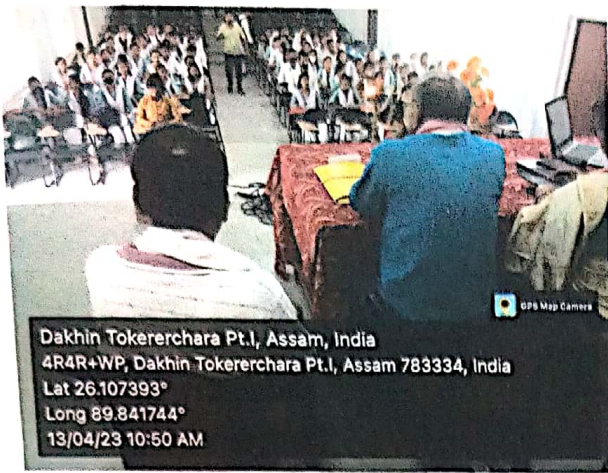
The workshop's practical applicability and participatory learning method were emphasised by the overwhelmingly positive feedback received from the attendees. Participant response highlights several key themes, including:
