

**CERTIFICATE COURSE IN RAJBANSHI LANGUAGE
(SELF-FINANCED)
CHILARAI COLLEGE, GOLAKGANJ**

Chilarai College, Golakganj takes an initiative to introduce a one year Certificate Course in Rajbangsi language in 2022 which is in consonance with the vision of NEP 2020 for promotion of Indian languages including regional languages. Offering the certificate course in Rajbangsi language is made possible by a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) of the college with the Koch Rajbangsi Sahitya Sabha located at Saktiashram, Kokrajhar(BTR), Assam. Revisiting the spoken tongue of Rajbangshis, it can be understood that the spoken form of this ethnic community has existed for centuries used in utterance by the clan called Koch Rajbangshis. It spread over Kamrup-Kamata kingdom that comprised of Dhubri, Kokrajhar, Bongaigaon and Goalpara district of Northeast India, some districts of West Bengal and extending upto Rangpur in Bangladesh. Diversity of the students is a hallmark of the college and most of the students belong to Rajbangsi community. The college thinks that many of the oral languages as well as their literary creations are facing threat of extinction as a result of the various forces of globalization. Hence there lies the responsibility of the college to safeguard and promote the language that spreads across borders. Some faculties of the college and some of visiting Professor/language experts have been actively engaged in classroom teaching-learning of the language. The one year Certificate Course comprises of two Semesters and students are required to submit Projects also.
